Manufacturing Mould holders is always a challenge, particularly ensuring the 'arms' remain level and at a consistent and stable height on assembly. The stack up of tolerances can deliver OOS holders. At Lattimer we have been working on identifying and delivering a reliable and consistent solution to this issue.

Adding and amending specific toleranced dimensions has resulted in the manufacture of holders consistently within acceptable limits of 0.002", without adding to the manufacturing time or cost.

As holder orders are received, drawings are now modified and the manufacturing methods adjusted to guarantee quality and consistency.


